Re: Proposed Material Amendments to the Draft Roscrea Local Area Plan 2023 – 2029

The National *Sustainable Mobility Policy*¹ (SMP) was published in April 2022 with a target of delivering at least 500,000 additional daily active travel and public transport journey, and a 10% reduction in kilometres driven by fossil-fuelled cars, by 2030. This ambition has since been superseded by updated targets in the Climate Action Plan 2023, namely 1.4 million additional daily sustainable journeys and a 20% reduction in total vehicle kilometres travelled by 2030

The SMP is built around three principles of safe and green mobility; people focused mobility; and better integrated mobility. Further information and a full list of actions can be found as part of the Action Plan at https://www.gov.ie/en/publication/848df-national-sustainable-mobility-policy/.

In making or amending any Local Area Plans, local authorities should have regard to the principles and objectives of the SMP, ensuring LAPs are drafted in line with these objectives
