



TIPPERARY YOUTH & FURTHER EDUCATION TRAINING CENTRE _ Consultation Document October 2022

The buildings and features highlighted in RED are intended to be removed to facilitate the creation of the youth and further education training facilities.




Site Plan As Proposed

The proposed extension is intended to create a new frontage to the facility with a central courtyard that will be activated by the uses in new and historic buildings.




View of the proposed development, showing the relationship of the proposed new extension in the foreground to Dan Breen House.

A forecourt to Dan Breen House leads to the new entrance, which in turn gives access to a centrally located courtyard bounded by new and historic structures.




View of the proposed development, showing the relationship of the proposed new extension to Dan Breen House.
