1. INTRODUCTION


- 1.1 This report describes a Stage 1 Road Safety Audit carried out at Emmet Place, Nenagh on behalf of Robin Lee Architects. The audit was carried out on 31st October 2023 in the offices of Roadplan Consulting, Kilkenny.
- 1.2 The audit team members were as follows:
 - George Frisby, BE CEng MIEI. Auditor Number GF51255
 - Richard Frisby, BSc AEng MIEI.
 Auditor Number RF1337391
 - Jince Philip Zachariah, PhD CEng.
 Observer
- 1.3 Both audit team members visited the site on the 11th July 2023. The audit comprised an examination of the drawings relating to the scheme supplied by Robin Lee Architecture and an examination of the site.
- 1.4 The speed limit along Emmet Place is 50 km/h.
- 1.5 This Stage 1 Audit has been carried out in accordance with the relevant sections of TII GE-STY-01024. The team has examined only those issues within the design relating to the road safety implications of the scheme and has therefore not examined or verified the compliance of the design to any other criteria.
- 1.6 All problems described in this report are considered by the audit team to require action in order to improve the safety of the scheme and minimise accident occurrence.
- 1.7 Appendix A lists the audited drawings.

2. STAGE 1 AUDIT

2.1 Location: Parking provisions at digital enterprise hub and residential development

Problem:

Parking facilities provided at the residential development and digital enterprise hub may be insufficient to cater for the expected number of users. This may force the users to park in undesignated areas such as on footpaths and could increase the risk of collisions with pedestrians if they are forced to travel along the carriageway.



Recommendation:


Ensure adequate parking is provided.

2.2 Location: Exits from parking areas at digital enterprise hub and residential development.

Problem:

Existing and proposed boundaries may obstruct visibility splays for drivers of vehicles exiting the proposed parking areas for the residential development and digital enterprise hub. A lack of adequate visibility splays may contribute to a side impact collision at these locations.

In addition, intervisibility between drivers of vehicles exiting the parking areas and pedestrians on the footpath crossing the accesses may be restricted by the existing and proposed boundaries. A lack of adequate intervisibility between drivers of vehicles exiting the parking areas and pedestrians on the footpath crossing the accesses may contribute to a pedestrian collision at these locations.




Recommendation:

Provide adequate visibility splays at both accesses.

2.3 Location: Residential development access road

Problem:

Bin storage for the residential is shown to be provided at the end of the access road. The collection strategy for bins has not been provided. The proposed access road appears insufficient to accommodate turning by refuse vehicles. Without adequate turning facilities, vehicles will be required to either reverse in or reverse out of the development. Reversing vehicles increases collision risk.




Recommendation:


Provide a turning head sufficient for refuse vehicles if feasible or, if not feasible, implement a waste collection strategy which includes a methodology for safe refuse collection.

2.4 Location: Parking facilities at digital enterprise hub and residential development

Problem:

The proposed parking facilities appears insufficient to accommodate turning by vehicles at times when all parking spaces are occupied. Without adequate turning facilities, vehicles will be required to reverse out of the development. Reversing vehicles increases collision risk.





Recommendation:

Provide a turning head within the parking areas.

2.5 Observation

Sign and/or road markings are not indicated in the drawings. It is assumed that appropriate sign and road markings will be provided.

3. AUDIT TEAM STATEMENT

3.1 We certify that we have examined the drawings listed in Appendix A and have inspected the site. This examination has been carried out with the sole purpose of identifying any features of the design that could be removed or modified to improve the safety of the scheme.





