Section 5 subsection 5.2.1

Heading no.4 refers to Martyr's / Dublin Road, this area includes and a number of local long-term tenants.

An agreement in principle, subject to conditions is in place to sell one acre of land to facilitate the creation of the "Centre of Excellence". This was entered into in the understanding that would fulfil its ambitions to re-develop the whole area. This now is clearly not possible in the foreseeable future with no likelihood of the E.S.B site becoming available and the uncertainty of when, if ever the Inner link Road (Railway Road) will be developed.

On this basis, while is committed to our agreement "in principle" to the sale of one acre, subject to conditions to facilitate the Centre of Excellence, must bear in mind that the business of manufacturing, warehousing and retail will continue on the remainder of our property, at least until are in the position to deliver the other essential elements for the further development of the area.
